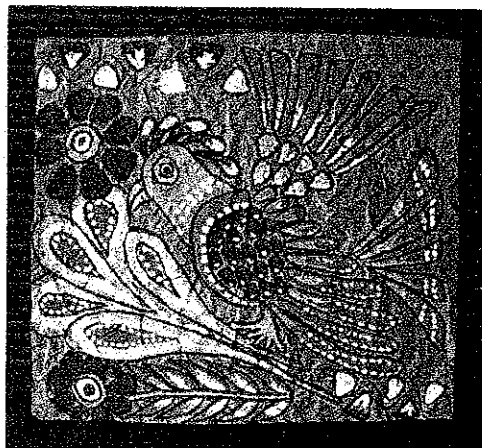
HOLA PADRES, PARENTS!!!!!!
